

What is the challenge?

Simply put, we are losing teachers in our WELS schools. In the last five years, a significant number of teachers have *walked away* from teaching—across America and in the WELS.

Why do these dedicated gospel workers leave?

Because they are facing challenges and demands on all sides: family issues, student learning difficulties, societal pressures. Because the pandemic exacerbated *everything*. Because sometimes teachers have to make major decisions in the glare of the public light—alone leaving them feeling isolated, vulnerable, unsupported.


Because even though they've been well trained in college and they're working faithfully, the *pressures in their ministries build up* until they are just too much to bear.

The fact is, we need teachers now more than ever!

God is blessing WELS schools with incredible growth in enrollment! We've gained almost 5,000 K-12 students in the last two years alone! All these students—all these souls—are hearing the gospel every day. And many are unchurched, which means they may be hearing about Jesus' love for them for the very first time.

WELS School Enrollment Increases (2013-2023)

- Early Childhood Ministries
 12.3% 1
- Lutheran Elementary Schools 23.7% 1
- Area Lutheran High Schools 35.0%

oaching for Teachers

Grace in Action has a Solution

We have been quietly piloting a *successful* coaching program to stem the tide of teacher attrition. We are stepping in and walking together with teachers who feel overwhelmed and overworked.



What's the cost of teacher loss?

When a teacher resigns, there is a considerable cost. Relationships fracture, institutional knowledge disappears, and morale plummets.

The child who gave her heart to a teacher feels abandoned. The teenager thinking about becoming a teacher sees his role model walk away from ministry. Fellow teachers who depended on that teacher's guidance and friendship are left bereft.

Schools may need to enlarge class size, which decreases individual attention. Or they may set enrollment caps and put students on waitlists. It's possible that some students may never get into that school to hear the gospel.

Then there's the financial cost. When a principal resigns, for instance, the cost of replacement is \$50,000 and three years of stagnation as the new principal finds his footing.

Teacher loss is a stewardship issue. GIA's coaching program can help preserve both teachers' gifts and the church's funds.

As wise King Solomon said, "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up" (Ecclesiastes 4).

Walking Together Coaching for Teachers



How does Walking Together work?

- GIA coaches teachers in both one-on-one relationships and cohorts.
- GIA provides tools for self-evaluation, good habits, ownership as a Christian leader, relationships, productivity, and followership. One such tool: CliftonStrengths®—an assessment tool that helps ministry leaders identify and apply their personal gifts.

GIA has already been working with principals and early childhood directors in our pilot program. And it is working!
